The Lunch Aide is responsible for preparing and serving food, maintaining outstanding food safety standards, and cleaning up while providing exceptional customer service to students and the school staff.

This position is part-time (~20 hours per week), and reporting hours will be from approximately 10am-2pm daily when school is in session.

This job description is meant to provide structure to the responsibilities and accountability of this position. There may be additional responsibilities assigned as the needs of students and of the school arise. The Lunch Aide will report to the Operations Manager and Head of School. \*Compensation offered is based on experience and performance.

## PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Maintains a food safe environment, complying with State, Federal, Edibles Rex, Detroit Health Department and school district food safety policies
- Ensures the kitchen area is clean before, during and after service
- Maintains food at the correct temperatures and completes daily logs of food temperatures
- Works under pressure in a fast-paced environment
- Adapts to an ever-changing daily work environment
- Observes and creates a safe work and serving environment
- Ensures adequate supply of condiments, milk, back-up meals, and supplies
- Serves the correct portion of designated food items
- Monitors meal service by using PoS systems, tally systems or other meal tracking systems.
- Maintains necessary safety equipment, signage and logs in a clean and organized way in the kitchen
- Establishes a culture of respect, hard work, consistency, and effective communications with all team members

- Effectively communicates to management any issues or concerns that may affect food safety or quality as well as customer issues
- Follows school policies and procedures with 100% compliance

### Physical demands:

- Standing for extended periods of time
- Use of hands and arms frequently
- Preparing and serving hot and cold meals daily
- Lifting up to 30 pounds, squatting, carrying pans of food, milk crates, and bread racks
- Adhering to all safety protocols to maintain a clean and safe environment for both students and staff
